

**Community Relations****Public Activities Involving Staff, Students and/or School Facilities****Public Complaints About Instructional Materials**

Any resident of the Watertown Unified School District may raise objections to instructional materials used in the district's educational program despite the fact that the materials were carefully selected by qualified individuals according to established criteria. Objections concerning instructional materials should be made in accordance with established procedures.

Any resident or employee of the school district may also formally request reconsideration of instructional materials used in the district's educational program on the basis of appropriateness. Procedures shall be developed for the reconsideration of instructional materials. These procedures shall be for the purpose of considering the opinions of those individuals in the schools and community who were not involved in the selection process.
