

Community RelationsPublic Activities Involving Staff, Students and/or School FacilitiesLottery Type Activities

Groups or individuals may not solicit contributions or sell tickets to school personnel, students or community members attending school activities except as approved by the school board.

Lottery or lottery type activities will not be approved except under the following conditions:

1. There are no cash prizes.
2. The total value of the item(s) to be raffled off is less than \$100.
3. The cost of a ticket is \$1.00 or less.
4. Tickets are sold by and to adults only.
5. Tickets will be sold from a booth or table where the adult customer would approach the sellers.
6. The non-profit organization is dedicated to supporting student programs and will use the funds received to the benefit of students.
7. The organization has the appropriate state license for the raffle.

When permission is granted, it will be good for one year and may be renewed.

(NOTE:) In order to be considered for a raffle license, the State Bingo Control Board requires the following: (1) the organization to be a non-profit organization in existence for at least one year and (2) the organization to complete a raffle license application form. Along with the application form, the organization is required to submit a copy of its constitution or by-laws and \$10.
