The Watertown Unified School District recognizes that cooperation between the officials of Watertown Unified School District and law enforcement agencies is necessary for the education and protection of students, for maintaining a safe environment in the schools of the District and for safeguarding all school property. The District also recognizes that the rights of the home, the civil authorities and of the individual student must be clearly understood and balanced with the District's duty to maintain an appropriate and fair learning environment.

The District Superintendent shall formulate administrative regulations to be used in the implementation of this policy.
