

Community Relations**Relations Between Non-Public and Other Educational Organizations and the Schools****Cooperative Education Programs**

The Watertown Unified School District Board of Education appreciates the fact that there are other agencies in the District, or area, which are dedicated to education. It believes that much may be gained through cooperative endeavors with these agencies.

In order to make a maximum contribution to education, within the District and to other educational agencies, the Board establishes these broad guidelines:

1. Efforts will be made to establish mutually beneficial cooperative programs with neighboring schools and other schools in CESA #2. This also includes the purchase of special services and equipment not economically available to the local district due to budget or personnel restraints.
2. The school administration is encouraged to establish liaison with other educational and non-educational agencies.
3. The school administration is encouraged to supply educational services to, and/or share with, other educational and non-educational agencies.
4. The District may participate in programs offered by other CESA's when approved by the Board.
