

Students**Activities****Student Conduct on School Buses**

The school bus is considered an extension of the classroom; therefore, students shall conduct themselves while on the bus in a manner consistent with established standards for classroom behavior. A set of bus rider rules shall be developed by the administration and distributed annually to all students who qualify for bus transportation.

When a student fails to conduct him/herself properly, such misconduct should be brought to the attention of the administration by the bus driver. Where continuing or extremely serious problems exist, the student's bus riding privileges may be suspended in accordance with established procedures.

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
