

Instruction**District Safety Program****Bomb Threats**

Being responsible for the safety of a large number of students, teachers and other staff personnel, it is incumbent upon school administrators to do all that is prudent and possible in the event of danger.

In the event of the interruption of the normal operation of the school because of an emergency created by some threat to the safety of the school and its inhabitants, the District administrator or his/her designee shall make an immediate decision for safeguarding the welfare of the school's population according to procedures outlined in the District's Crisis and Safety Plan Building procedure plans will be updated and reviewed annually and so communicated to the Board by the September Regular Board Meeting.

Any School time missed because of a bomb threat interruption shall be made up as directed by the Board.

Persons suspected of making a bomb threat shall be referred to law enforcement officials. In addition, any student involved in making a bomb threat shall be subject to school disciplinary action, including possible expulsion from school, and shall be expected to make restitution to the District for costs associated with the bomb threat to the extent authorized by law.
