

New Construction**Occupying****Dedication of Project**

The School Board holds the authority for naming or renaming schools, facilities, and properties in the Watertown Unified School District. Naming of a school district facility or property shall be by a majority vote of the entire Board.

The Board believes naming facilities and properties is a matter of great importance, and deserves thoughtful attention. Written procedures shall be established and followed in naming facilities of the District.

Naming rights may be awarded by the Board for substantial gifts and/or service to the District. Should such naming rights be awarded, they would be subject to Board approval. To be considered for naming rights, gifts shall first meet or exceed all of the criteria for approval and acceptance by the Board. In addition, the awarding of naming rights may acknowledge substantial gifts to the District that endow programs, positions, or other recurring costs; may be appropriate with regard to type of structure or area to be named or other compelling reasons to be determined by the Board; and may commemorate extraordinary distinguished service to the District over an extended period of time.
