STUDENT / PARENT SUMMER SCHOOL CONTRACT**

The following regulations for summer school are strictly enforced at the high school level. Your signature acknowledges you will agree to all regulations.

DRESS AND CONDUCT:

Students are expected to follow the same standards of dress and conduct as those which are in effect during the school year. See the student handbook if you are unfamiliar with these standards. Not following these standards can result in suspension from summer school. Any suspension from summer school equals one whole absence.

ATTENDANCE:

Students enrolled in summer school classes must attend all classes. Students who are absent for more than two class sessions will not receive credit. Summer school does not allow for any excused absences such as vacations, doctor appointments, illnesses, accidents, deaths, etc. PLAN ALL VACATIONS AND APPOINTMENTS AROUND THE 20 DAYS OF SUMMER SCHOOL!

TARDY POLICY:

Students are required to be in their classrooms when the bell rings at the beginning of each session and at the end of all breaks. If a student is not in the room when the bell rings, they are considered tardy.

ATTENDANCE SCALE - GRADES 9-12

Students must accumulate 54 attendance points to meet the attendance requirement for Summer School. A maximum of three points may be earned each day. A full term maximum total is 60 points.

Perfect daily attendance	=	1 point (per class segment)
Tardy (through 4m, 59s)	=	7/8 point
Tardy (5m through 9m, 59s)	=	3/4 point
Tardy (10m through 19m, 59s)	=	1/2 point
Tardy (20 min. or more)	=	1/4 point
Full absence	=	0 points

m = minutes s = seconds

Early departures result in point totals commensurate to the points earned for various degrees of tardiness. For example, a departure of up to 5 minutes early equals 7/8 point.

If a student both arrives late AND leaves early during the SAME class segment, this will result in an attendance score of zero for that segment.

Students are free to leave summer school on the last two days IF they have met their academic and attendance requirements.
