RE: Teaching Applications - Summer School 2012

It is now January and summer school planning for 2012 is under way. In past years Erin Meyer and her assistants coordinated all aspects of summer school. This year there has been a slight change in duties. Erin will still be in charge of summer school; course planning, room assignments, supplies, registrations, fees, etc. The difference is that the hiring for summer school has now been assigned to the Human Resources Department.

This letter is being distributed to teachers not currently employed by Watertown and Watertown substitute teachers. Every year it takes a large number of teachers to run the comprehensive program Watertown has had and our teaching staff has been an important part of the success of the program.

If you are interested in teaching summer school, please complete and return an application to the Human Resources Office at the ESC no later than **January 23, 2012**. If you are NOT interested in teaching summer school but may be interested in substituting occasionally, please check the appropriate box on the application. **It is understood and expected that if you are contracted to teach for summer school you will teach all of the 20 scheduled days.** The 2011-12 Master Agreement retained the wages for summer school at the hourly rates of 2011.

June 20 through July 18, 2012 (NO school on Wednesday, July 4)

*\*The majority of grades 1-4 and 5-8 classes will end at 11:30 or noon; however, several afternoon sessions will be offered between 12:35 and 2:30 pm for those students needing to stay the entire day.*
