Participation by the Public

Citizen Advisory Committees

In order to help accomplish specific tasks, be advised of public opinion, and/or to help inform the public of WUSD needs, the Board of Education may appoint Citizen Advisory Committees. The composition of such committees may vary with the specific tasks to be accomplished and shall balance the need for representation with the need for efficiency and expertise. Appointments to a Citizen Advisory Committee shall be made at the discretion of the Board and/or the Superintendent.

Citizen Advisory Committees shall be appointed and charged with a specific task and timeline for completing their charge. Upon completion of the charge, the Citizen Advisory Committee shall report to the Board and then be discharged by the Board.

Action of Citizen Advisory Committees shall be considered advisory. Only the Board has the legal power to act and make decisions which are binding upon the WUSD, or commit the WUSD to a course of action.
