

Community RelationsPublic Activities Involving Staff, Students and/or School FacilitiesLottery Type Activities

Groups or individuals may not solicit contributions or sell tickets to school personnel, students or community members attending school activities unless it has gone through the approval process.

Lottery or lottery type activities will not be approved except under the following conditions:

Clubs, organization and/or activities that use a raffle must have a raffle permit from the state. All raffles must have prior approval by the Building Administrator, Superintendent and the Board of Education. All raffles must follow District and state guidelines. The permit must be presented to the appropriate administrator and raffle number recorded.

When permission is granted, it will be good for one year and may be renewed.

(NOTE:) In order to be considered for a raffle license, the State Bingo Control Board requires the following: (1) the organization to be a non-profit organization in existence for at least one year and (2) the organization to complete a raffle license application form. Along with the application form, the organization is required to submit a copy of its constitution or by-laws and \$10.
