

New Construction**Planning****Forecasting Enrollments**

Enrollment forecasts shall be prepared under the direction of the Superintendent of Schools or designee, utilizing current enrollment information supplemented with data furnished by the annual District census and the regular District census, as well as regularly revised enrollment.

The Superintendent of Schools or designee shall report to the Board of Education concerning attendance areas, housing developments, and any other developments that may have an impact upon building needs. Such matters in this particular item of consideration may be:

- Non-public schools' closings, openings, or expansions
- Housing projects, building permits, and apartment complexes
- Industrialization
- Highway constructions
- Municipal consolidations
- Changes in sewer, water – which may affect an entire area
- Economic Development Reports

In addition, consideration will be given to potential enrollment impact due to charter school enrollment and voucher/parental choice programs.
