

**New Construction****Designing****Building Design**

Minimum standards for school building design, as specified in the state school laws, shall not be looked upon as limiting factors in creative school design.

The primary guiding principle in school design must be the educational program to be served. There is, in addition, the extremely important but intangible matter of aesthetics, particularly as they reflect the aspirations of people for their schools. Equipment and fixtures shall be selected to fit the building design and prepared by the Superintendent and Director of Business Services.

The superintendent of schools and his/her staff shall delegate the responsibility for asking the board to approve building plans which best reflect the above point of view.
